Spring House offers stability and the opportunity to help women and their children help themselves. The Program is designed to meet the needs of women in crises as it builds confidence, self-esteem, and independence.

SPRING HOUSE is a transitional group home located in Eatontown, NJ. Operating since 1990, its goal is to provide shelter to homeless young mothers and their children, enabling the women the opportunity to gain self-sufficiency while living in a safe, supportive environment. Spring House can accommodate nine mothers and ten children. The length of stay is nine to twelve months, depending on each case. The Monmouth County Division of Social Services refers the women to Spring House.



*The residents of Spring House sign a contract agreeing to work towards completing their high school education, attend parenting and life skills classes and delay additional pregnancies. While at Spring House they receive guidance in:*
